Testosterone and its effects on behaviour.

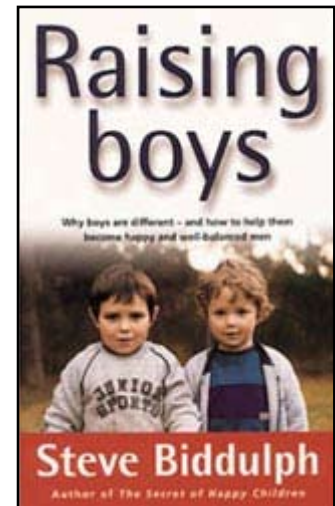
